



Dear Parents/Carers, please find below a brief overview of the curriculum that your child will be learning during Summer Term. If you have any questions, please get in contact. Thank you. Mrs March.

	<p>Maths - Number – Fractions and Decimals, Measure – Money and Time, Statistics and Geometry – Properties of Shape and Position and Direction. <i>Your child will also complete Mathstastic, Big Maths and Times Tables Olympics each week as well as practising their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.</i></p>
	<p>English - Fiction – Why the Whales Came by Michael Morpurgo, which will include: writing their own stories, character descriptions, newspaper reports as well as spelling, grammar, punctuation and comprehension. Non-Fiction – Whales and their Habitats, which will include writing non-chronological reports and fact files.</p>
	<p>Science – Sound – Children will learn how sounds are made, how sound travels and they will design and create their own musical instrument.</p>
	<p>Computing - Design label/ adverts using a range of tools e.g Publisher Incorporate video/ pictures into other products e.g. advert or PowerPoint</p>
	<p>PE – Athletics – Pass the Baton and Faster, Higher, Further Net and Wall Games – Mini Tennis Striking and Field Games – Zone Cricket and Zone Rounders</p>
	<p>Geography – Children will study Europe, using maps to identify European countries. They will also study and understand why Italy ‘shakes and roars’. If time and Coronavirus allows, we will also carry out some fieldwork on coasts and pay a visit to one of my favourite places - Seaham.</p>
	<p>Art – Printing and Drawing – Study the work of MC Escher Sculpture and Form - Study a range of cultural African Art</p>
	<p>Design and Technology – Children will design, make and evaluate a musical instrument.</p>
	<p>Music – Children will continue to be taught how to play the Ukulele by Mr Elliot from Durham Music Service.</p>
	<p>RE - Christianity – What do Christians believe about Jesus? Why do Christians call Jesus the light of the World? What do we know about the Bible and why is it important to Christians? How and why do people show care for each other? Why do people visit Durham Cathedral?</p>
	<p>MFL – French – At the Café. Children will learn a range of French words and phrases that they would use if they were visiting a French Café.</p>
	<p>PSHCE – Living in the Wider World</p>
