<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Number: Decimals and percentages Geometry: Properties of Shape Geometry: Position and Direction Measurement: Converting Units</p> <p>We will also complete Mathstastic and Times Tables Olympics each week.</p>

<p>PE</p> 	<p>Athletics and Net-Wall Games Our PE lessons are on Wednesday and Friday.</p>
<p>History</p> 	<p>Local Area Study – Esh Winning. We will step back in time to investigate and explore the history of Esh Winning.</p>
<p>Geography</p> 	<p>Origins of key foods Key Question: Where has my food come from? We will explore the sustainability element behind the food we eat, trade links, natural resources, thematic maps, industry, farming and employment.</p>
<p>Art</p> 	<p>Sculpture and Form Wire sculpture and research in the style of artist Martin Wright.</p>
<p>Design and Technology</p> 	<p>Textiles – Design and make a drawstring bag.</p>
<p>Music</p> 	<p>Fresh Prince of Bel Air Focus: Scratching, old school hip hop, graphic score, rap, decks. Backing loops.</p>
